OBJECT DESCRIPTION

Inside the bag is doily-making material. The bag is clear with red and blue designs on it and the entire casing is stained and damaged. The opening is pinned shut with two pins. The designs depict images such as a castle with birds flying around it within a red triangle, as well as writing in Greek. Inside the bag is a small rolled stack of white doily-making material.

ORIGIN

The exterior wax paper bag is not the original container. It was donated by MaryAnn G.P. Satryb. Crochet and embroidery are distinct aspects of Greek culture, particularly as activities for women.
