OBJECT DESCRIPTION

Orange short Stanchion rope. At each end there is a metal hook, made out of aluminum or steel. There are two bolts inserted into the base of the metal hook castings to anchor them to the stanchion rope. These bolts are on opposite sides of each other.

ORIGIN

A stanchion is an upright, non-permanent fixture used primarily to guide the formation of lines of people and are used in many events and gathering types from bank lines to theme park lines and more. There is no strictly Greek provenance.
