OBJECT DESCRIPTION

A large rectangular paper ticket with a perforated left-hand edge and a perforated top right corner. "The Museums are Open:" Then the headings, "Museums, 10 Oct. - 31 March, 1 April - 30 September" And then all the times for the Archaeological, Acropilis, Epigraphic, and Numismatic museums for those dates. At the bottom are the times for Sundays and Holidays, and prohibitions against smoking and touching the artifacts.
