OBJECT DESCRIPTION

Small rectangular cutwork mat with rounded corners. The top and bottom feature a large stem of ten grapes, with a leaf on either side. One of the openings in a leaf hasn't been cut out. The fabric is cream-colored, and the threading is more of a yellowish.

ORIGIN

The cutwork technique originated during the Italian Renaissance during the 14th, 15th, and 16th centuries. This mat would be used as decoration or to protect the table surface.
