OBJECT DESCRIPTION

Small matchbox with purple sides. The top has a light blue background and features a large white and gold phoenix with outstretched wings rising skyward from of an island of bright orange flames. ORIGIN

This matchbox was from the junta occupation, which lasted from 1967 to 1974. It was a dictatorship that ended with the Turkish invasion of Cyprus. The oppression led to an absence of civil rights and an aura of fear among many of the population. The Junta Occupation started with a coup that happened on the 21 of April in 1967.
