ATHENS - The new 622-year-old George Dinos - renowned musician and artist - is a tribute to the Republic of Cyprus and its people, their traditions, history which today is mentioned in Turkey's flag, comprising of 27% of its land, and the enduring hope for peace and reconciliation.
