 This is the transcript of an oral history interview with Aris Anagnos, conducted by Faye Lellios on February 24, 2007. The interview took place at the National Hellenic Museum in Lincoln, Massachusetts. Aris Anagnos is a 62-year-old male of Greek descent who was born in Greece and immigrated to the United States in 1944. He is currently a resident of Lincoln, Massachusetts. The interview covers his childhood in Greece, his immigration to the United States, his education, his career, and his views on the Turkish invasion of Cyprus in 1974. Aris Anagnos speaks in English throughout the interview, with occasional Greek words and phrases. The transcript is a verbatim transcription of the audio recording, with some minor corrections for clarity. The interview is part of the National Hellenic Museum Oral History Collection (OH1).
