OBJECT DESCRIPTION

Harold Gene Markos donated pictures of his father and great uncle at Virden Candy Store. Candy stores offered a big job market for Greek immigrants. When they first would come to America, not many jobs would be available. Many times they would open carts and sell traditional Greek food. As demand grew, they made more money and eventually opened stores.
