ORIGIN

Anna K. Keramaianakis (10/26/1904-10/16/1984) married Kyriakos V. Petrakis (1/1889-1/1968). Anna lived in Spilia, Crete. Her grandfather sold olives in the city of Chania. Anna and her mother and sisters raised silk worms and sold the thread they spun. Anna's aunts arranged an engagement. She and Kyriakos were married on July 28th, 1926. On August 15, 1926 they left Crete for Athens. On September 2nd, 1926, they left for American on board the "Avera." On October 5th, 1926, they arrive at Ellis Island in New York.
