Chris Ladis lived from September 30th, 1893 through December 11th, 1979. He became a U.S. citizen on November 2nd, 1918, and was inducted into service for WWI on July 24th, 1918. He was discharged from service March 12th, 1919. He was a corporal in the Medical Department as a Motor Ambulance Chauffer.

Chris resided in Canaryville since he arrived in Chicago from Turkey.
