ORIGIN

photograph of Mayor Richard J. Daley and Archbishop Iakovos shaking hands during the first Chicago Greek Independence Parade to celebrate the Greek Declaration of Independence of 1821. Mayor Richard J. Daley was currently in the middle of his term as mayor, came from a heavy Irish background in the South Side of Chicago. Archbishop Iakovos is the leader of the Greek Orthodox Church in the United States.
