## **OBJECT DESCRIPTION**

White table runner with geometric embroidered pattern on hem of the short sides in brown, gold and sky blue. Some of the designs are in the shape of fans, with a golden outline, brown cones at the top with blue circles on the point of the cone, and either a brown or a blue cone shape on the inside. The top and the bottom have a light blue border. At the bottom, there is a repeated design of two curly golden lines pointing opposite directions with a blue or brown dot in the middle below all of the fans. In between the fans at the top, there is the outline of a brown triangle missing its bottom with a blue line below it and a curved blue line on the inside, there are two yellow lines to either side of this design, the middle of this runner is plain.

## **ORIGIN**

Embroidery was originally used to reinforce seams and could be seen as a part of a girl's transition into womanhood.
