Dear Mrs. Carter,

You will receive from my bank (Bank of Geneva) Geneva, a check of USD \$ 700, sent directly to you a few minutes ago.

Please, kindly note one thing that is very important for me:  
I must leave Istanbul before the American group, that is on July 6th at 4.30.

Mrs. Amy Stein who knows the reasons assured me that there is a flight on July the 6th from Istanbul to Athens at 4.30 p.m. She was even so kind to assure me that Mr. Stein would stay with me at the airport until I'll be on the airplane.

I wish you do all reservations under your own responsibility. I want to be registered in all cases as a member of the American group, invited by Mr. and Mrs. Stein. Mrs. Stein can explain you every thing. Also, these last days three articles appeared in the American press preparing the international opinion that a war between Greece and Turkey, this summer, is inevitable. (see "New York Times")

If, you could not get the reservation Istanbul Athens for the 6th of July, then the only other solution could be to leave with the group for London, on July the 7th, and go from London to Athens next, if possible at the same day! But this season such more complications and fatigue and money spent for nothing. So, please, try to assure my flight to Athens directly from Istanbul on July the 6th.

I am sending a copy of this letter to Mrs. Amy Stein. Anythanks for everything.
