 to receive, journalist, radio, TV etc... I hope I'll be
 able to - include a some words on peace, etc etc, about
 speaking in Kaganakis or Zonta.
 On April 23, I have to leave for Chicago on 24. I
 have public talks on my way to Greek of Chicago. On
 25 I have to visit my family somewhere near Chicago.
 Then go on, with her father, Luberman and the father
 to Japan, Long Kong - Cambodia, Nepal, Ceylon, Java.
 He is very vague that is a recent tourism program
 for Kentucky that is in such bad health as myself.
 I hope I will be able to visit some
 persons and speak with them about peace. I have
 200 names of tortured persons in Greece. There are
 many more hundreds but they are afraid to confess
 what they have suffered. These 1300 are ready to tell
 everything - etc (L.K.)
