

Greece, June 16, 1972

Dear Kay,

This, I believe, will be my last letter from Greece. On June 20, I'll leave the Olympic Hotel to welcome you. (On June 17, I am flying to Athens.)

For the moment I bought 5000 (one thousand) Turkish Liras, this amount we, tourists, are allowed to bring with us in Turkey. And I'll have with me 500 U.S.A. \$ and 1000 S. frs. in traveller checks. I think it will be enough - except... except if we found some precious Cypriot byzantine coins of the silver ones - who knows were they sell them except in London!! And at what price. And how to be sure that it is an authentic one! Everybody now knows about coins and everybody comes to Greece with the hope to acquire one or more, with legal or more often illegal means.

Now, let us hope everything will be O.K. and all the joy for us in the very next future.
