OBJECT DESCRIPTION

Long women's skirt made out of bright magenta satin. Skirt is pleated and pressed with a cinched drawstring waist, which ties in the back with a blue string.

ORIGIN

Amalia Greek costume, a Greek women's costume that originated with Queen Amalia of Oldenburg (who arrived in Greece during 1837), who actually created the costume by drawing on romantic folksy court dress inspired by Greek traditional dress and the Biedermeier style. It became a national Greek

costume, and the dress became the usual attire worn by Christian Greek townswomen
