OBJECT DESCRIPTION

Small white pillow sham. Each side of the pillow is bordered with a light blue satin, each close to or a little over three inches. On the inside edge of the satin is white stitching. Center is plain white. The back of the sham is all white and just has a simple flap opening for the pillow to slide into to.

ORIGIN

Created by Penelope Neokos. She was born in Greece in 1899. In later years she came to the United States with her husband Nickolas, also native to Greece, where they became citizens of Illinois and lived in the city of Chicago.
