## OBJECT DESCRIPTION

Knitted cream baby bootie with pink coloring on the toe, slightly faded. There is also a stitched pink flower with green stem on the top of the foot. There is a small sting at the ankle, which would be tied into a bow. The ankle of the boot comes about an inch and a half above the tie and finishes in a curved edging.

## ORIGIN

Crocheted and knitted by Theodora Price herself in the early 1970's. She had left Greece in 1962 for graduate studies in England, after which she worked for a bit in the University of Sydney, and then migrated to America in 1967, to New York and later came to Chicago in 1968. She taught Greek art and Archaeology at the University of Chicago. When she was pregnant with her first son she quit teaching and researching and did fulltime preparation for motherhood. This piece was finished before her son's birth.
