OBJECT DESCRIPTION

One cream colored stocking.

Tightly knit cream colored cotton. Wider at the top and becomes narrow at the bottom. At the bottom there is a small white cotton strap that connects one side to the other. On one side of the stocking, halfway down, there is a small yellow/brown stain. There is also a small amount of black hair/fuzz throughout the stocking.

ORIGIN

The stocking was donated on behalf of Louis Vellos who brought the object from Greece in the early 1950s.

The stocking is part of a child's Foustanelia. The Foustanelia is the official uniform for the Evzones who are the Presidential Guards. The Foustanelia is the official costum of men. The look includes a loose-fitting shirt, an embroidered vest, Fez hat, Tsarouxia (shoe), and fustanella which is a skirt-like garmet.
