OBJECT DESCRIPTION

A needlework piece bordered in light brown velvet. Within that, colorful flower vines are embroidered into a rough brown background. The picture in the middle displays four men (one obscured) walking over a bridge. Each man is dressed in vibrant, dated clothing and carrying an object- possibly instruments. In the back of the picture there is a large colorful tree and a landscape of green grass behind blue water. The back is water stained.
