OBJECT DESCRIPTION

A needlepoint piece with a light brown velvet border. At each corner of the border there is an old, frayed cream colored bow. Within the velvet border there is a geometric pattern of ovals and rectangles in green with red accents. There are red lines around the pattern. In the center of the cloth there is a man

in red on a chestnut colored horse. The horse is trotted on grass above big needlework flowers of extraordinary colors.
