**OBJECT DESCRIPTION**

Long a-line skirt with loose pleats. Drawstring waist. Evergreen embroidered detailing at hem with silver coins.

**ORIGIN**

This Vlahopoula (Daughter of the Mountain) costume could be 150 years old. It was brought from Constantinople by a Greek school teacher, who came to Phoenix, AZ where Maria Fakonas met her. Maria saw the costume and bought it in 1965 for her daughter Toni.
