OBJECT DESCRIPTION

A rectangular candy box from the Ting-a-Ling candy store in Chicago. The box is rectangular in size, and has a brown patina to it. The front face of the box depicts a two-story New England style house with trees, and the lettering "Ting-a-Ling" in the top right corner. The words "Home Made Candies" also appear in the bottom right section, and the candy store's address appears in the bottom right section of the front face. The reverse face of the box is blank.

ORIGIN

The Ting-a-Ling Chocolate Shoppe was a well-known, Greek-owned confectionery shop located on Chicago's north side.

When the establishment went out of business, Ward Miller, a local Chicago architect, entered the premises and saved a number of valuable artifacts, including this one.
