OBJECT DESCRIPTION

A single custom made hand-held rubber stamp for the Ting-a-Ling candy shop. Handle is of red wood. Stamp imprint creates wording stating: "Ting-a-Ling. We Make Our Ice Cream & Candy. We Serve Dinners. 42 W. Division St., Chicago"

ORIGIN

The Ting-a-Ling candy shop was a well-known, Greek-owned confectionary shop located on Chicago's northside.

When the establishment went out of business, Ward Miller, a local Chicago architect, entered the premises and saved a number of valuable artifacts, including this one.
