OBJECT DESCRIPTION

All the items are set against a white mounting.

ORIGIN

The Bank of America Chicago Marathon is an annual marathon that attracts hundreds of thousands of runners from around the world every October in Chicago. The donated piece was presented at the 2011 Inaugural Ball for the National Hellenic Museum by the Chicago Bank of America executive.

The marathon itself has its origins in Greece.
