OBJECT DESCRIPTION

An oil painting by Andreas Kodros made in 1994. The top is a light blue sky and there are a few green hills around the middle of the picture. ORIGIN

Dr. Andreas Kodros was born in Athienou, Cyprus and earned his medical degree at the University of Athens School of Medicine in 1952. He finished his residency in Otolaryngology at the University of Illinois and then went on to practice medicine at the Weiss Memorial Hospital, St. Joseph's Hospital, and the Children's Memorial Hospital until 1987. Dr. Kodros also studied art at the Pancyprian Gymnasium in Nicosia, Cyprus. He mostly uses oils but also works with watercolors, acrylics, and airbrush. His art has been on exhibit at many places in Cyprus and the United States. He passed away in 2002 and his wife a year later.
