OBJECT DESCRIPTION

Large cotton greek flag. Official flag with the blue and white colors stripped to make up 9 stripes and the cross in the upper left corner.

ORIGIN

Found in collections

Elias Kokonis started an umbrella business in 1887 in Smyrna, Ottoman Empire (Turkey today). In May of 1919 during WWI and the Greek Occupation Elias started secretly making flags to support his heritage, and business started booming. By 1922 the Turks took back over control and Elias and his family were forced to flee with nothing but the clothes on their backs. Once settled in Athens, Greece Elias reopened his shop from scratch in 1927. Today his granddaughter Eleni Kokonis runs the shop and they sell trades flags, flagpoles, banners, trophies, medals, and umbrellas. They make over 200 different countries flags.
