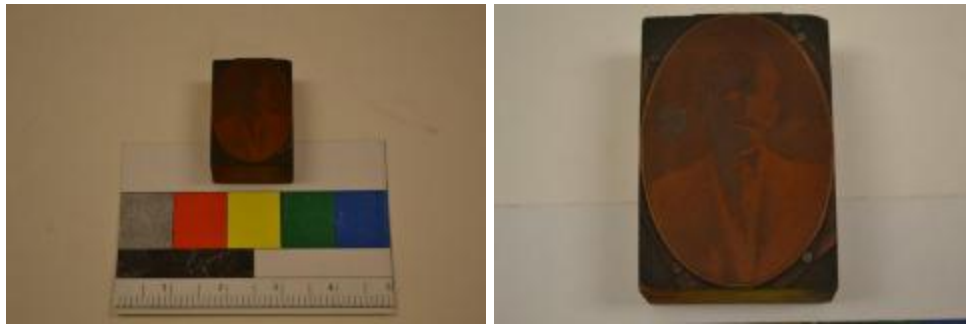

OBJECT DESCRIPTION

Wooden and copper printing block. Rectangular shaped block with an oval-shaped printing face. The corners of the metal face have been cut away. Upon the face of the oval is the portrait of a man with a beard and moustache and wearing a suit, vest, shirt, and tie.

ORIGIN

Donated by John Damianos. The printing block was used in a linotype printing machine. Linotype presses allowed for the casting of entire lines to be printed at a time. Linotype printing was eventually succeeded by lithograph printing and computer typesetting during the 1960's and 1970's. This printing block was used by the Chicago-based, The Greek Art Printing Company. It is unknown who the man depicted in the portrait is.
